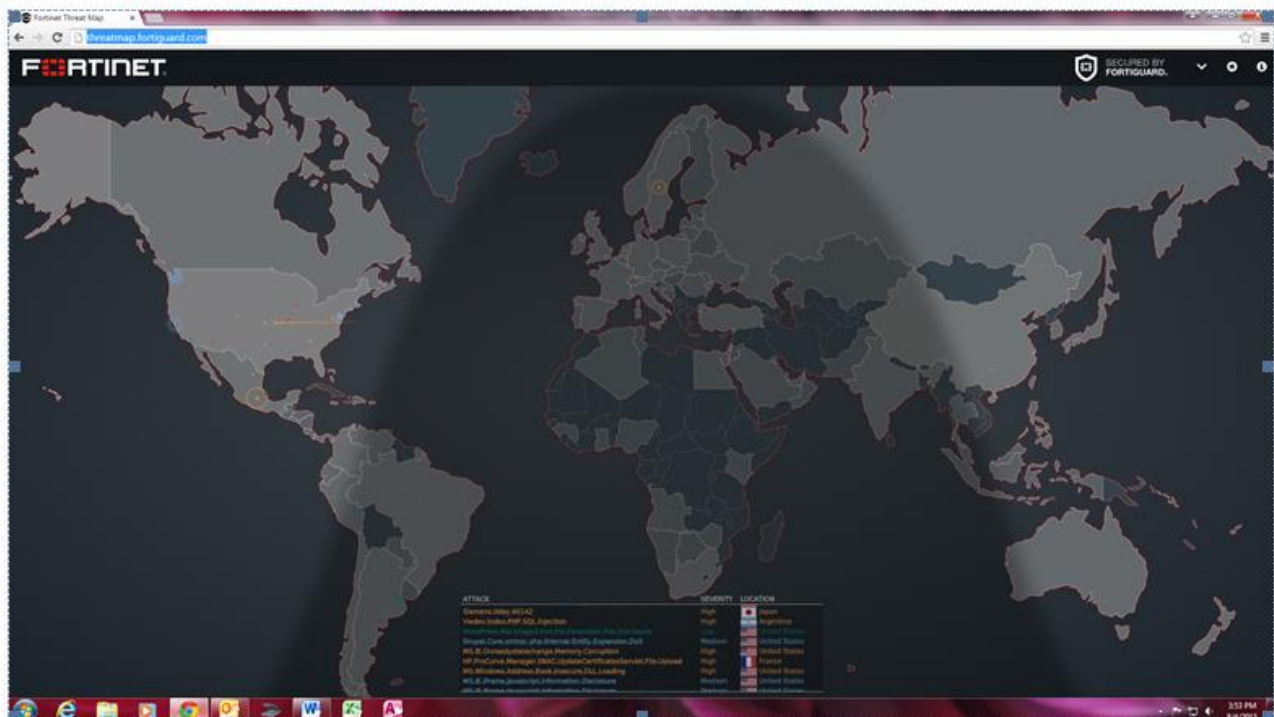


Helping Credit Union Supervisory Committees Perform at Their Peak
