Key Elements of Disaster Planning

- Gain senior management buy-in
- Engage dedicated resources
- Think about people first
- Consider worst-case scenarios
- Build-in crisis communication plan and messaging
- Know who's in charge... 2nd in charge...3rd...and so on
- Location is central to recovery plans
- Anticipate the impact of back-up facilities and demand surge
- Determine preparedness of partners and vendors
- Test, practice and update plans regularly
